A3 Design **A** will be used as a package for a metal cup. Orthographic views of the metal cup are shown below.



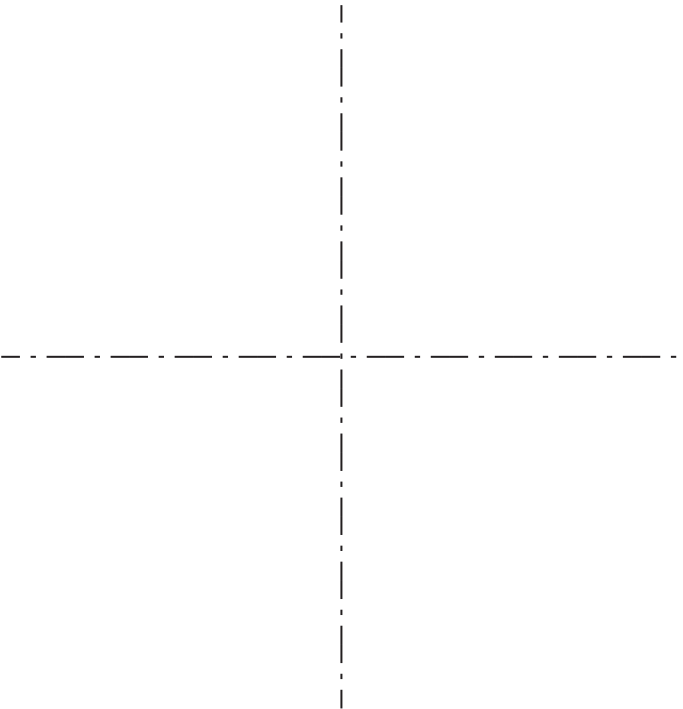

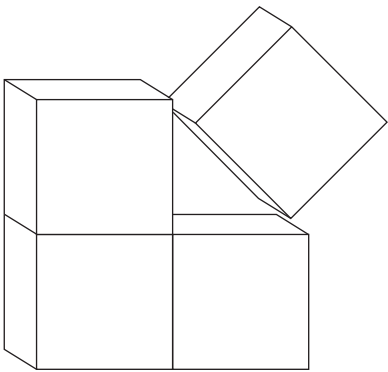
